GIFTS OF SERVICE

- __ Pray regularly for the work and staff of CVEM
- __ Provide Thanksgiving dinner for a family
- __ Adopt a family at Christmas
- __ Make follow-up support calls to persons helped at CVEM
- __ Drive your truck to help move donated items
- __ Assist with mail-outs
- __ Provide simple home repairs
- __ Help with CVEM Christmas party
- __ Show & sell Café Pins at your work / civic /social group

GIFTS OF MONEY

- __ Sponsor a low-income senior citizen in Brown Bags, a monthly supplemental food program (\$30 for 3 months; \$60 for 6 months; \$120 annually)
- __ Provide a family with Angel Foods box - nutritious and more than enough food to feed a family of four for a week (\$30)
- __ Contribute towards assistance with rent or mortgage (\$50/\$100)
- __ Provide youth scholarship for camp, sports, music, art, tutoring (\$25/\$50)
- __ Provide education scholarship assistance towards tuition, books, equipment, uniform (\$25/\$50)
- __ Help with a tank of gas (\$20)
- __ Contribute towards the purchase of an appliance or furniture (\$50)
- __ Help towards a medical need: co-payment, doctor visit or purchase of eyeglasses (\$25)

GIFTS OF ITEMS

- __ Locate/donate appliance
- __ Locate/donate furniture items, linens
- __ Donate car
- __ Provide sports equipment/uniform or musical instrument for one child
- __ Shop yard sales/thrift shops to locate specific items (CVEM reimburses!)

- __ Legal assistance to a family or individual
